

The Sampson County Board of Commissioners convened for a special called meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, June 16, 2025, in the Sampson County Auditorium, 435 Rowan Road, Clinton, North Carolina. Members present: Chairman Allen McLamb, Vice Chairman Eric Pope, and Commissioners Houston Crumpler, III, Thaddeus Godwin, and Lethia Lee.
