The Sampson County Board of Commissioners convened for a Special Called Meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 30, 2026, in the Administrative Board Room, 406 County Complex Road, Clinton, North Carolina. Members present: Chairman Allen McLamb, Vice Chairman Eric Pope, and Commissioners Houston Crumpler, III, Thaddeus Godwin, and Lethia Lee.

Chairman McLamb called the meeting to order and acknowledged Vice Chairman Pope who called upon Commissioner Godwin to provide the invocation. Vice Chairman Pope then lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Agenda

Upon a motion by Commissioner Lee and seconded by Commissioner Crumpler, the Board voted unanimously to approve the agenda as presented.

Item 1: Resolution Authorizing Participation in the Remnant Defendant Opioid Settlement Agreement

Chairman McLamb called upon County Attorney Joel Starling who reviewed a resolution authorizing the Chairman to execute a participation form for the Remnant Defendant Opioid Settlement Agreement, accepting the settlement and releasing those defendants. Upon a motion by Commisisoner Godwin and seconded by Commissioner Lee the Board voted unanimously to adopt the resolution as presented.

Item 2: Budget Amendment

Chairman McLamb called upon Finance Officer Melissa Burton who presented a time-sensitive budget amendment for the Sampson County Animal Shelter. Upon a motion by Vice Chairman Pope and seconded by Commissioner Crumpler the Board voted unanimously to approve the budget amendment as presented.

Item 3: Budget Workshop

Chairman McLamb called upon County Manager Allen Vann who shared a brief presentation recapping the March 9, 2026 Pre-Budget Workshop and highlighting budget preparations and recommendations thus far. The Board then received updates from the Sheriff's Office, Information Technology Department, Veteran's Services Office, Register of Deeds, Tax Office, Libraries, Animal Shelter, Sampson Area Public Transportation, and Economic Development Office.

Upon a motion by Chairman McLamb and seconded by Commissioner Godwin the Board voted unanimously to recess to reconvene on Monday, May 11, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. in the Administrative Board Room.
