SCOPE OF SERVICES

1. General

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to award a contract to a local supplier to provide vehicle repairs on all Sampson County owned vehicles. Sampson County has approximately 290 vehicles that would be covered under the contract.

A list of services is included on the bid form herein. This RFP does not include towing, nor does it include brake repair or tire maintenance/repair. The services required under this RFP are listed on page 6.

The County desires to enter into a one-year agreement with the option to extend for two additional one-year periods under the same terms and condition and upon written mutual agreement of both parties.

2. Request for Service

Vehicle repairs will be requested by the individual departmental employees of Sampson County who are assigned a county vehicle. Only county-owned vehicles are covered under this contract. **In an effort to continue operating efficiently, Sampson County shall receive priority service over the general public.**

3. Statement of Responsibility

No additional services should be performed on any Sampson County vehicle. Contractor may provide a written estimate to the Sampson County employee for additional work discovered during the vehicle repair, but no work, other than what is listed on the proposal form, shall be performed. Towing services are not included under this proposal. Tire and brake repairs are also not covered under this proposal.

4. Invoices

For each vehicle serviced under this agreement, the awarded contractor will maintain and keep a record of the following information and provide it to the County on a monthly basis:

- Date vehicle brought in for vehicle repair services
- Make and Model of vehicle
- License plate number
- County vehicle number
- Service(s) performed
- Detailed billing prices in accordance with bid form

It is the desire of the County of Sampson to pay promptly. To It is the contractor's responsibility to submit invoices directly to the Finance Department and address specified on the contract or as "Ship and Bill to" on the Purchase Order. Payment is normally made within thirty (30) days from receipt of accurate invoice.

5. Records

The awarded Contractor shall keep and maintain records of all vehicles which have been serviced under the contract for a period of three (3) years. These records shall include the date of service, license plate number, vehicle identification number, year, make, and model, and county vehicle number.

6. Other Requirements

The Contractor shall comply with all federal, state and local laws and regulations applicable to operations covered by this contract including, by way of illustration and not limitation, the following:

- The Contractor shall possess a business license, if required under the City/County Code.

7. Vehicle Security

All Sampson County vehicles shall be kept secured while in the awarded contractor's possession. Unless being actively serviced, all vehicles shall be locked and all vehicle keys shall be secured. To the extent provided by the law, the awarded contractor shall be accountable and liable for damage or loss to Sampson County vehicles, to any and all personal property in the vehicles, and for all vehicle accessories and equipment. The awarded contractors shall be responsible for returning the vehicle in the same interior and exterior condition as it was received.

8. Confidentiality

The Contractor and his/her employees are expected not to share details to the general public, other employees, and/or the media about any vehicle brought in for service.

Any verified information found by the County of the Contractor and/or his/her employees releasing information to the general public or media via person-to-person communication, telephone communication, social media, and/or other means; **will terminate** the contract immediately between the Contractor and the County.

9. Sample Agreement

Attached is a *Sample* Service Agreement that describes the County's contractual terms and conditions. The awarded Contractor will be required to enter into a service agreement with the County. Any exceptions to the terms and conditions of the Service Agreement must be documented and listed on the "Exceptions to the Proposal and Sample Agreement" form.

THIS CONTRACT is made, and entered into this the ____ day of _____, by and between the **COUNTY of SAMPSON**, a political subdivision of the State of North Carolina, (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY"), and _____, a corporation duly authorized to do business in the State of North Carolina, (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR").

For and in consideration of mutual promises to each as herein after set forth, the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

- 1. SCOPE OF SERVICES.** CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to provide the services and/or materials under this Contract pursuant to the provisions and specifications identified in "Attachment 1" (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Services"). Attachment 1 is hereby incorporated herein and made a part of this Contract. Time is of the essence with respect to all provisions of this Contract that specify a time for performance.
- 2. TERM OF CONTRACT.** The Term of this Contract for Services is from _____, 2025 to _____, 2026 unless sooner terminated as provided herein.
- 3. PAYMENT TO CONTRACTOR.** CONTRACTOR shall receive from COUNTY an amount not to exceed _____ (\$) as full compensation for the provision of Services. COUNTY agrees to pay CONTRACTOR at the rates specified for Services performed to the satisfaction of the COUNTY, in accordance with this Contract, and Attachment 1. Unless otherwise specified, CONTRACTOR shall submit an itemized invoice to COUNTY by the end of the month during which Services are performed. A Purchase Order number may be assigned to encumber the funds associated with this Contract and must appear on all invoices and correspondence mailed to Purchaser. Payment will be processed promptly upon receipt and approval of the invoice by COUNTY.
- 4. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR.** COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree that CONTRACTOR is an independent contractor and shall not represent itself as an agent or employee of COUNTY for any purpose in the performance of CONTRACTOR's duties under this Contract. Accordingly, CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for payment of all federal, state and local taxes as well as business license fees arising out of CONTRACTOR's activities in accordance with this Contract. For purposes of this Contract taxes shall include, but not be limited to, Federal and State Income, Social Security and Unemployment Insurance taxes.

CONTRACTOR, as an independent contractor, shall perform the Services required hereunder in a professional manner and in accordance with the standards of applicable professional organizations and licensing agencies.

- 5. INSURANCE AND INDEMNITY.** To the fullest extent permitted by laws and regulations, CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and hold harmless the COUNTY and its officials, agents, and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses, and expenses, direct, indirect, or consequential (including but not limited to fees and charges of engineers or architects, attorneys, and other professionals and costs related to court action or arbitration) arising out of or resulting from CONTRACTOR's performance of this Contract or the actions of the CONTRACTOR or its officials, employees, or contractors under this Contract or under contracts entered into by the

CONTRACTOR in connection with this Contract. This indemnification shall survive the termination of this Contract.

In addition, CONTRACTOR shall comply with the North Carolina Workers' Compensation Act and shall provide for the payment of workers' compensation to its employees in the manner and to the extent required by such Act. Additionally, CONTRACTOR shall maintain, at its expense, the following minimum insurance coverage:

\$1,000,000 per occurrence /\$2,000,000 aggregate --- Bodily Injury Liability, and

\$100,000 --- Property Damage Liability, or

\$1,000,000 per occurrence /\$2,000,000 aggregate---Combined Single Limit Bodily Injury and Property Damage

Automobile Liability \$100,000 Bodily Injury per Person /\$300,000 Bodily Injury per Accident / \$50,000 Property Damage per Accident, or

\$300,000 Automobile Liability Combined Single Limit Bodily and Property Damage

CONTRACTOR, upon execution of this Contract, shall furnish to the COUNTY a Certificate of Insurance reflecting the minimum limits stated above. The Certificate shall provide for thirty (30) days advance written notice in the event of a decrease, termination or cancellation of coverage. Providing and maintaining adequate insurance coverage is a material obligation of the CONTRACTOR. All such insurance shall meet all laws of the State of North Carolina. Such insurance coverage shall be obtained from companies that are authorized to provide such coverage and that are authorized by the Commissioner of Insurance to do business in North Carolina. The CONTRACTOR shall at all times comply with the terms of such insurance policies, and all requirements of the insurer under any such insurance policies, except as they may conflict with existing North Carolina laws or this Contract. The limits of coverage under each insurance policy maintained by the CONTRACTOR shall not be interpreted as limiting the CONTRACTOR's liability and obligations under the Contract.

6. **LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION, AND REGISTRATION OF PERSONNEL.** All personnel provided or made available by Contractor to render services hereunder shall be licensed, certified or registered, as appropriate, in their respective areas of expertise as required by applicable North Carolina law.
7. **CONFIDENTIALITY.** All data and information, both written and verbal, furnished to Contractor by County shall be regarded as confidential, shall remain the sole property of County and shall be held in confidence and safekeeping by Contractor for the sole use of the parties and Contractor under the terms of this Agreement. Contractor agrees that its officers, employees and agents will not disclose to any person, firm or entity other than County or County's designated legal counsel, accountants or practice management consultants any information about County, its practice or billing.
8. **HEALTH AND SAFETY.** CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for initiating, maintaining and supervising all safety precautions and programs required by OSHA and all other regulatory agencies while providing Services under this Contract.
9. **NON-DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT.** CONTRACTOR shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, sex, race, creed, national origin, or disability. CONTRACTOR shall take affirmative action to ensure that qualified applicants are employed and that employees are treated fairly and

legally during employment with regard to their age, sex, race, creed, national origin, or disability. In the event CONTRACTOR is determined by the final order of an appropriate agency or court to be in violation of any non-discrimination provision of federal, state or local law or this provision, this Contract may be canceled, terminated or suspended in whole or in part by COUNTY, and CONTRACTOR may be declared ineligible for further COUNTY contracts.

10. GOVERNING LAW. This Contract shall be governed by and in accordance with the laws of the State of North Carolina. All actions relating in any way to this Contract shall be brought in the General Court of Justice in the County of Sampson and the State of North Carolina.

11. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT. This Contract may be terminated, without cause, by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party. This termination notice period shall begin upon receipt of the notice of termination. Such a termination does not bar either party from pursuing a claim for damages for breach of the contract.

This Contract may be terminated, for cause, by the non-breaching party notifying the breaching party of a substantial failure to perform in accordance with the provisions of this Contract and if the failure is not corrected within ten (10) days of the receipt of the notification. Upon such termination, the parties shall be entitled to such additional rights and remedies as may be allowed by relevant law.

Termination of this Contract, either with or without cause, shall not form the basis of any claim for loss of anticipated profits by either party.

12. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS. CONTRACTOR shall not assign its interest in this Contract without the written consent of COUNTY. CONTRACTOR has no authority to enter into contracts on behalf of COUNTY.

13. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS. CONTRACTOR represents that it is in compliance with all Federal, State, and local laws, regulations or orders, as amended or supplemented. The implementation of this Contract shall be carried out in strict compliance with all Federal, State, or local laws.

14. E-VERIFY. As a condition of payment for services rendered under this agreement, CONTRACTOR shall comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the General Statutes. Further, if CONTRACTOR provides the services to the County utilizing a subcontractor, CONTRACTOR shall require the subcontractor to comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the General Statutes as well. CONTRACTOR shall verify, by affidavit, compliance of the terms of this section upon request by the County.

15. IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT. CONTRACTOR certifies that they are not listed on the Final Divestment List created by the State Treasurer pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-6A-4. Individuals or companies on the Final Divestment List are ineligible to contract or subcontract with Local Government Units. (G.S. 143C-6A-6(a).) It is the responsibility of each vendor or contractor to monitor compliance with this restriction. Contracts valued at less than \$1,000.00 are exempt from this restriction.

16. DIVESTMENT FROM COMPANIES THAT BOYCOTT ISRAEL. The vendor or contractor certifies that it has not been designated by the North Carolina State Treasurer as a company engaged in the boycott of Israel pursuant to N.C.G.S. 147-86.81. It is the responsibility of each vendor or contractor to monitor compliance with this restriction. Contracts valued at less than \$1,000.00 are exempt from this restriction.

- 17. GOOD STANDING WITH COUNTY.** CONTRACTOR certifies that it is not delinquent on any taxes, fees, or other debt owed by CONTRACTOR to COUNTY. CONTRACTOR covenants and agrees to remain current on any taxes, fees, or other debt owed by CONTRACTOR to COUNTY during the Term of this Contract.
- 18. NOTICES.** All notices which may be required by this contract or any rule of law shall be effective when received by certified mail sent to the following addresses:
- 19. AUDIT RIGHTS.** For all Services being provided hereunder, COUNTY shall have the right to inspect, examine, and make copies of any and all books, accounts, invoices, records and other writings relating to the performance of the Services. Audits shall take place at times and locations mutually agreed upon by both parties. Notwithstanding the foregoing, CONTRACTOR must make the materials to be audited available within one (1) week of the request for them.
- 20. COUNTY NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR EXPENSES.** COUNTY shall not be liable to CONTRACTOR for any expenses paid or incurred by CONTRACTOR, unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- 21. ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AND FUNDING.** This Agreement may be subject to the annual appropriation of funds by the Sampson County Commissioners. Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, in the event that funds are not appropriated for this Agreement, then County shall be entitled to immediately terminate this Agreement, without penalty or liability, except the payment of all contract fees due under this Agreement up to and through the last day of service.
- 22. EQUIPMENT.** CONTRACTOR shall supply, at its sole expense, all equipment, tools, materials, and/or supplies required to provide Services hereunder, unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- 23. ENTIRE CONTRACT.** This Contract, including Attachment 1, shall constitute the entire understanding between COUNTY and CONTRACTOR and shall supersede all prior understandings and agreements relating to the subject matter hereof and may be amended only by written mutual agreement of the parties.
- 24. HEADINGS.** The subject headings of the sections are included for purposes of convenience only and shall not affect the construction or interpretation of any of its provisions. This Contract shall be deemed to have been drafted by both parties and no interpretation shall be made to the contrary.
- 25. EXISTENCE.** CONTRACTOR warrants that it is a corporation duly organized, validly existing, and in good standing under the laws of the State of North Carolina and is duly qualified to do business in the State of North Carolina and has full power and authority to enter into and fulfill all the terms and conditions of this contract.
- 26. AUTHORITY.** By execution hereof, the person signing for CONTRACTOR below certifies that he/she has read this Contract and that he/she is duly authorized to execute this Contract on behalf of the CONTRACTOR. This Contract, together with any amendments or modifications, may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which shall be considered one and the same agreement. This Contract may also be executed electronically. By signing electronically, the parties indicate their intent to comply with the Electronic Commerce in Government Act (N.C.G.S § 66-358.1 et seq.) and the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (N.C.G.S § 66-311 et seq.). Delivery of an executed counterpart of this Contract by either electronic means or by facsimile shall be as effective as a manually executed counterpart.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the parties have expressed their agreement to these terms by causing this Service Contract to be executed by their duly authorized office or agent.
